What to do if	Action needed	Return to school when
My child or another family member has Covid-19 symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Keep school updated • Self-isolate, follow guidance • Book a Covid-19 test • Inform school immediately about test results 	The test comes back as negative .
My Child tests positive for Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Keep school updated • Self-isolate (at least 10 days) • Inform school immediately about test result • Keep siblings off too • Seek guidance from TTP 	They can return to school after 10 days (siblings after 14 days if not showing symptoms) even if they have a cough or loss of taste/smell. These symptoms can last for several weeks once the infection is gone.
Somebody in my household has Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Keep school updated • Self-isolate • Household member to book a Covid-19 test • Inform school immediately about test result 	The household member test is negative or self isolation is completed
Somebody in my household has tested positive for Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Keep school updated • Self-isolate for 14 days 	The child has completed 14 days of self-isolation
NHS Test & Trace have identified my child as a 'close contact' of somebody with symptoms of confirmed Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Book a Covid-19 test • Keep school updated • Self-isolate for 14 days 	The child has completed 14 days of self-isolation. The Covid-19 test comes back as negative .
