

As mentioned previously, we operate at low ratios, with highly experienced staff and we strive to encounter high levels of adventure and challenge. We achieve excellence in adventure education through immersion and interaction in the natural spaces of the world. Each day we will go on fantastic and wide-ranging adventures

that are appropriate to the wants and needs of the group, the weather, and the educational outcomes we are striving to achieve.

Our programme is flexible and dynamic, which allows us to be adaptable in ensuring that we consistently meet the needs of the students we have.

The activities will not be limited to, but will likely include; rock climbing, mountaineering,

scrambling, canoeing, gorge walking, white water kayaking, bushcraft and beach activities.

In addition to our adventurous day activities, we will also provide a full evening of supervision which includes fun and social activities, plus some 'down time' to relax and recuperate. We finish each Myddelton Adventure Camp with a campfire party and the Myddelton Bushcraft Challenge!
