Climbing


Enjoya climbing session guided by professional trainers in the stunning Welsh landscape.

Travel dates

Arrival day to the camp will be on Sunday and departure is Saturday. Flight times for international students should be between 8am and 8pm to qualify for free airport transfers. Airport transfers are available from Manchester airport only.

Cancellation

The Applicant is entitled to cancel their place on a Programme at any time before the programme has started. In the event of any cancellation by the Applicant, the Applicant must provide written notice to Myddelton College. If the notice of cancellation is received by Myddelton College before the commencement of the Programme, the Applicant shall be entitled to receive a refund of the amount of Programme Fee received by Myddelton College (less the non-refundable deposit of £400) calculated as follows:

Number of days prior to commencement of the programme	% refund of programme fees received less non-re-fundable deposit
30+ days	100%
15 - 30 days	50%
0 - 14 days	0%

Refunds will be made to students who have been refused a visa, provided the reason for refusal is not due to a fraudulent application or error on behalf of the applicant. To request a refund, students must submit a copy of the visa refusal document to the school. This does not supersede the above refund policy.

Terms & Conditions

- In order to secure a place on a course an application form and deposit must be completed and submitted to the school or a recognised agent or partner.
- The college reserves the right to alter the timetable. It is the parent's responsibility to declare any medication that a student is taking and to declare any medical issues at the time of application.
- All images/videos of summer school students taken by the school may be used for marketing purposes (Unless you opt out on the application form).
- The college reserves the right to allocate alternative teaching facilities and accommodation without prior notification.
- Fees are not transferable to other students and the school reserves the right to cancel or amend a course when necessary.

Course Rules:

- Students are expected to attend all meals, classes and organised activities and excursions.
- Students are required to keep their rooms tidy and to make their own beds.
- Alcohol or drug consumption or possession is prohibited, and will lead to immediate dismissal.
- Smoking or vaping is not tolerated at the school and this includes activities and excursions off-site.
- Racist or intimidating behaviour towards staff or students will not be tolerated and will result in dismissal from the course.
- Within the school accommodation, male and female students are only permitted to mix in designated recreation areas, not in bedrooms.
- All personal electronic devices including mobile phones must be switched off during organised activities.
- Group leaders are expected to support students throughout the duration of their stay.
